Creating a shared school vision



Blackshaw Moor First School have worked really hard to engage all stakeholders of the school and create a whole school vision of what the PE and sport provision will look like in 2020 – once the funding has ended. Subject leader **Ruth Knott** worked with county PE advisor Caroline Holder and developed an effective strategic action plan each year to lead up to achieving this 2020 vision. She reports regularly to governors on the progress and reviews and adapts her plan as

needed. She has also created a list of things all the children will have experienced or achieved by the time they leave the school to sit alongside the PE national curriculum offer.

Impact: The profile of PE and sport has been raised and there is a cohesive vision for the school with all stakeholders on board and supporting the work. All staff have received CPD and are more aware of and behind the current recommendations and guidance for health, well-being and importance of PE. The pupils are now benefitting from this increased confidence and awareness through the schools PE and wider sport offer.
